



  - Flexibility on technology specifications

- REDII provisions on the one-stopshop
- Good practices from MS transposition of the Directive
- Good practices outside the scope of RED:
  - Positive silence under certain conditions
  - Digital tools and procedures

 Ensuring staffing in line with expected project deployment to meet NECP targets




